	Chairman welcomed members and the public to the meeting.		
	Chairman invited any of the public to address the meeting.		
	Mrs Briggs said that the topic she wished to raise was an agenda item.		
	Mr Morgan outlined his ideas for the dock footpath and expressed his		
	disappointment that members had not bothered to meet up with him to discuss his		
	concerns as a member of the public had slipped and fallen into the dock.		
	Reports from Outside Authorities		
	(a) Devon & Cornwall Police. The clerk read an email from PCSO Cocks saying there		
	were no reported crimes in the parish during the last month. He urged members to		
	report any breaches to the lockdown laws. He had carried out numerous patrols and		
	all appeared in order.		
	(b) Cornwall Council. Cllr Martin spoke about Covid 19 and how the number of		
	confirmed cases was increasing rapidly, Cornwall Council were treating the situation		
	as a state of emergency. He said testing was increasing and vaccines were being rolled		
	out and most vulnerable patients at Lostwithiel surgery should be vaccinated in the		
	next few weeks. He then went on to speak about the proposed changes to planning		
	regulations, climate change and rural broadband.

	received information that the hall might be eligible for another grant. Cllr Martin
