## 8. Planning Applications.

- PA21/08119 Erection of a polytunnel and a greenhouse Fawen Lerryn Lostwithiel PL22
   OND Councillors attended a site meeting. This field needs to remain an agricultural field;
   Polytunnels are not a material change of use, a domestic greenhouse is. Planning will only
   be supported if the greenhouse is not sited in the field but at their own domestic premises.
   Support given on this condition only.
  - The following statement was submitted on the online planning portal: "After Careful consideration of this application and the ecological appraisal, St Winnow Parish Council have agreed to support the installation of the polytunnel and the gateway drainage improvements. However, the Parish Council would insist the domestic greenhouse is not allowed. In order to protect the ecology in the valley we would also request the tunnel is screened with trees to protect the visibility from the south to ensure it settles within the landscape. The type of plastic used should be green and netted with green, to ensure that no reflective light issues occur at night to protect nocturnal species."
- 2. PA21/09404 Hawksbill Farm Erection of a Kitchen Diner Extension All Councillors were unanimous in publishing the following statement onto the online planning portal "St Winnow Parish Council has no objections to this planning application but would like it to be more inkeeping with the surroundings. The flat roof should be pitched and slated to blend and settle within the character of the main building. Visibility from the junction onto the A390, opposite the dwelling should be visibly appealing and sympathetic with the built

- environment of a rural location. St Winnow Parish Council has concerns that a flat roof will look like a shipping container."
- 3. PA21/09858 Tregonning Lerryn, Construction of a garden room. This application was discussed at length with no objections.
